

Road to International Grade Umpire

The International grade is an honour and privilege to which many umpires aspire but only the most competent should ever achieve.

The absolute basic requirements is a 4 yearly retest at National level with a pass mark of 97% and a level 3 marking certificate, before consideration and invitation to join the International panel.

Subsequent addition requirements, prior to consideration: are a record of your last 4 years of National duties and County finals, endorsed by your Area secretary.

1. At least one residential indoor event e.g. Nottingham or which venue is available from EIBA.
2. One Middleton Cup/Johns Trophy semi Final.
3. One Liberty / Atherley final.
4. One Denny / Yetton final weekend.
5. One Top Club / semi or final
6. At least one satisfactory assessed use of lollipops at Leamington, e.g. semi- final or final of a championship (NOT competition event, i.e. a competition which progresses to a British Isles level.
7. All assessed by a member of the development team.

These provisions also apply to incoming international umpires from other associations or jurisdictions.

All assessment results shall be passed onto the International selection Committee for their final decision
