

Expenses for Umpires and Markers, for the 2018/9 Season. Indoors and Outdoors

Inter-County Events Outdoors

White Rose Trophy/Walker Cup/Balcomb Trophy (pre-Regional Finals)	1	£15/£25 per umpire*	Participating counties – equal split
White Rose Trophy/Walker Cup/Balcomb Trophy (Regional Finals)	2	£15/25 per umpire*	Participating counties – equal split

* *The charge for the umpire for inter-county events will be £15 (up to 60 miles return journey) and £25 (over 60 miles return journey)*

Indoor National Championship Events (leading to National Championship Finals)

Event	No. of Umpires	Fee	Payable By
Semi-Finals & Finals ONLY	On request – including markers for singles events	£5 (first 20 miles) then 20p per mile	EBUA (Bowls England donation)

INDOORS Regional Finals

The Association are prepared to fund travelling at 20p a mile for:-

1. Major National Competitions - finals day. (which result in playing in the National Finals).
2. Major Q/Final and Semi-Finals, **if played on the same day**, (which result in playing in the National Finals).

All “Cups”, “Plates & “Trophies” from Semi Final up.

Up until then local umpires to be used and no travelling will be paid.

For Semi-finals and Finals the travel claim is £5-00 for the first 20 miles, plus 20p a mile thereafter

Only claims on our official appointment letter will be paid, also it must be signed by the claimant.

All claims must be backed up with a letter of appointment from the Area Secretary, or County Co-ordinator. If umpires are asked by the governing bodies or area competition secretary, without informing the A.S or C.C. they are not to be back dated after the job has been done.

On no account will we pay a match fee.

PLEASE NOTE ATHERLEY & LIBERTY TROPHY

All rounds 2 umpires for each, which must be claimed by the umpires from the Counties who are playing on the day as EIBA competition Rules “National Inter County Championships” rule 7.

Quote “Prior to the final the Challenger will be responsible for providing umpires. Teams will share green fees and Umpires expenses”. To be selected by Area Secretary, with input by County co-ordinator.
