

Funding for Indoor & Outdoor Expenses for Umpires and Markers, as at 1st October 2016/updated 26th June 2017

**The Association will pay funding from Bowls England for National finals at Leamington,
and Indoor finals at various venues as per EIBA schedule.**

OUTDOORS

Regional Finals

The Association are prepared to fund travelling at 30p a mile for:-

1. Major County Competitions - finals day. (which result in playing in the National Finals).

2. Major Q/Final and Semi-Finals (which result in playing in the National Finals).

Where the mileage is less than 33 miles a sum of £10-00 will be paid, if claimed.

Over 34 miles it will revert to 30p a mile.

3. Middleton Cup & Johns Trophy, all rounds 2 umpires for each. To be selected by Area Secretary, with input by County co-ordinator.

4. Walker Cup, Balcombe Trophy & White Rose Trophy all rounds 1 umpire for each, to be selected by Area Secretary, with input from County co-ordinator

Only claims on our official appointment letter will be paid, also it **must be signed** by the claimant.

On no account will we pay a match fee.

**ALL COUNTY GAMES, WHICH ARE USUALLY PLAYED ON VARIOUS GREENS, ON
VARIOUS DATES UP TO THE QUARTER FINAL - LOCAL UMPIRES TO BE USED - NO
CLAIMS ENTERTAINED.**

INDOORS

Regional Finals

The Association are prepared to fund travelling at 30p a mile for:-

As per numbers 1 & 2 above.

All "Cups", "Plates & "Trophies" from Quarter Final up.

Up until then local umpires to be used and no travelling will be paid.

When National "Finals" are played as per EIBA schedule, the sum of 30p a mile will be paid for all the mileage, where the mileage is less than 33 miles a sum of £10-00 will be paid, if claimed.

Over 34 miles it will revert to 30p a mile.

Only claims on our official appointment letter will be paid, also it **must be signed** by the claimant.

On no account will we pay a match fee.

All claims must be backed up with a letter of appointment from you're the area secretary, or County co-ordinator, If umpires are asked by the governing bodies or area competition secretary, without informing the A.S or C.C. they are not to be back dated after the job has been done.

PLEASE NOTE ATHERLEY & LIBERTY TROPHY

All rounds 2 umpires for each, which must be claimed by the umpires from the Counties who are playing on the day as EIBA competition Rules "National Inter County Championships" rule 7 Quote "Prior to the final the Challenger will be responsible for providing umpires. Teams will share green fees and Umpires expenses" To be selected by Area Secretary, with input by County co-ordinator.
